Telephoning Your Doctor

Most problems are best addressed during consultation with your doctor. However, a nurse is available during normal surgery hours for advice over the phone. Our nurse is experienced in determining whether your matter requires an appointment, a return phone call from the practice or a direction to an emergency medical facility.

Test Results and Follow-Up Appointments

If your GP has requested further investigations (eg x-rays, scans, blood tests, specialist referral) it is important you make a follow-up appointment with the GP to discuss all test results. Even if the results are normal, further investigation may be required. Please note test results are not permitted to be released over the phone in accordance with our privacy policy.

Your Privacy

All patients' information collected by PYMS is private and confidential. It will not be disclosed to any other service without your written consent (the only exceptions are noted in the Client Consent Form). A full copy of the Privacy Policy can be obtained from reception staff.
