



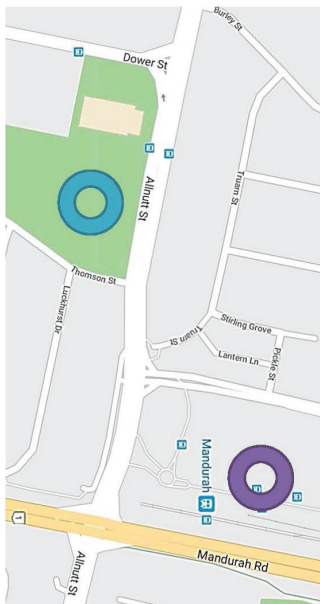
Assertive Outreach Team
