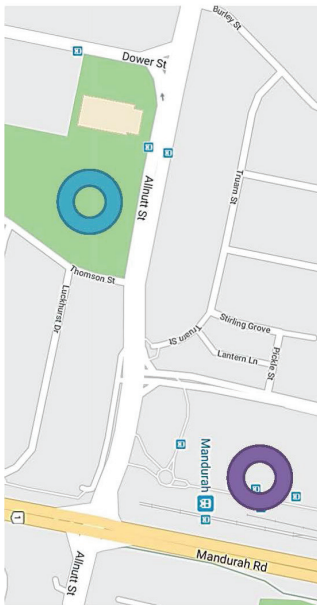
Aboriginal Youth Workers
